



## **32RED.com FLAT JOCKEYS' CHAMPIONSHIP PRIZE** **DONATED TO CHARITIES BY RYAN MOORE**

RYAN MOORE will be crowned Champion Flat Jockey for the second year in a row by championship sponsor 32Red.com at Newmarket Racecourse on Friday 30 October.

32Red will be donating £3232.32 to the Injured Jockeys Fund, £3232.32 to Racing Welfare for the Malton Fire Disaster Fund, with a third £3232.32 to the 2009 32Red Champion Jockey Ryan Moore.

Ryan said: "Although I am obviously delighted to have become Champion Flat Jockey for the third time, 2009 is a year that jockeys will remember for the terrible loss of apprentices Jan Wilson and Jamie Kyne. It is great that 32Red is donating to the fund. I am also pleased to split my prize between the Malton Fire Disaster Fund and the Injured Jockeys Fund."

Although the Flat racing season on the turf will still have a week more to run, Ryan is so far ahead at the head of the championship table that he will not be caught. That week, he travels to California for the Breeders' Cup.

Ed Ware, 32Red's Chief Executive, said: "This is a wonderful gesture by Ryan who is a most deserving winner of the 32Red.com Flat Jockeys' Championship for 2009. There is no cause closer to the hearts of those in the Weighing Room at the moment than the Malton Fire Disaster Fund set up after the tragic events in Yorkshire in early September.

"With donations to the Injured Jockeys Fund too, this means a total payment of nearly £10000 to two worthy causes in the world of horse racing and of the jockeys in particular."

The two teenage riders Jan Wilson and Jamie Kyne died when fire swept through the flats where they lived in Malton, North Yorkshire.

The award for the Jan Wilson & Jamie Kyne Apprentice Championship 2009 will be presented on the last day of the Flat racing season at Doncaster Racecourse on Saturday 7 November.
