



GEORGE BAKER UPDATE

Following a fall during the first race at St Moritz on Sunday 26th February, George Baker was transferred by air ambulance to Graubunden Hospital in Chur, Switzerland, where he has remained in a stable condition in intensive care. Having had CT scans earlier in the week George underwent an MRI scan today.

Following those MRI scan results, George has suffered from some bleeding in the brain and we are anticipating a long rehabilitation process, but are hopeful that he will make a positive recovery. George will remain in hospital in Switzerland whilst arrangements are made for his return home to commence his rehabilitation.
