

PJA BADGES & PASSCARDS ISSUED BY THE PJA 2020

You must ensure that you carefully read the Terms and Conditions of Issue of your Metal Badge and PASS Card, as outlined below. Disregard of these Terms and Conditions will result in immediate withdrawal, and the issue of a badge and PASS card for future years will be reviewed and may also be withdrawn.

All metal badges must be accompanied by a PASS Card, which must be presented each time you attend a race meeting and when you wish to collect additional guest badges. Please note that if you wish to arrange guest badges you must make the request directly and not via a third party.

The Racecourse Association send out separately the Terms & Conditions relating to PASS Cards, which should be read in conjunction with the following information.

Entry to each racecourse is subject to the Terms and Conditions of entry at that racecourse and these must be complied with. Please note that PASS Cards are NOT renewed annually. Where a PASS Card is termed "valid at all times", this is subject to the terms listed under SPECIAL CONDITIONS (see below).

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS/ENTITLEMENTS FOR ENTRY TO RACECOURSES AS FROM 1ST JANUARY 2020

Fully Licensed Jockeys

- Fully licensed Jockeys, who are members of The PJA will be issued with two PJA metal badges, one for their sole use and one to be used by their nominated person (non-transferable) in conjunction with the terms of their PASS Cards. **Under no circumstances should a Jockey or their nominated user allow their badge to be used by a third party.**
- One Category 'A' PASS Card (a named card with photograph), which is valid at all times.
- One Associated Category 'A' PASS card (in the name of a nominated person with photograph). **This card is valid at any Course where the Jockey is engaged to ride or when accompanied by the Jockey (who must have swiped their own PASS Card).** This card may only be used by the Jockey's nominated person and is for their sole use. Associated PASS cards and badges **must not** be used to claim additional complimentary badges.
- A Jockey's car park label

Apprentice and Conditional Jockeys

- Category 'A' PASS Card (a named card with photograph) which is valid at all times and allocates that Jockey a one day badge for movement within the racecourse. **When the Apprentice/Conditional Jockey is engaged to ride** this PASS Card allows the allocation of **two "day" badges**, one for the Jockey plus one other.
- A Jockey's car park label

SECURITY

- Badges are numbered and a record of issue is kept by the Professional Jockeys Association and the Racecourse Association. Any loss or return of badges is published monthly in the RCA UPDATE.
- **Lost PASS Cards must be reported to the PASS Helpline - pass@weatherbys.co.uk. Lost badges must be reported to the PJA immediately on 01635 778108.**
- Badge holders are recommended to examine, at regular intervals, the rings that secure the cord. If there is any indication of weakness, the badge should be returned to the PJA and a replacement badge will be issued free of charge.

- PASS Card/Badge holders must co-operate fully with racecourse officials conducting spot checks.

EXTENT OF USE OF THE BADGE AND PASS CARD

- If a Jockey requires additional badges when riding, they must contact the racecourse in advance. Contact numbers can be found on the RCA website.
- PASS Cards are the only means of **access** to Racecourses which operate the PASS System.
- Entry to each racecourse is subject to the Terms and Conditions of entry at that racecourse with particular reference to Special Conditions for those undertaking media work.
- PJA badges will admit only Professional Licensed Jockeys to the Weighing Room.
- Misuse of a metal badge or a PASS card will result in its withdrawal and the issue of a badge and PASS card in future years will be reviewed and may also be withdrawn.
- The badges and car park labels are strictly non-transferable and abuse of either one will result in the badge/label being withdrawn.
- Racecourses may conduct spot checks and your co-operation at such times is required.
- Jockeys retain responsibility for all badges issued to them, their nominated users and guests and must ensure that out of date badges are not used to attempt to gain entrance to racecourses.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

PJA badge holders – Access to Owners & Trainers facilities

PJA badge holders will be given access to the Owners & Trainers facilities at the discretion of individual racecourses. In order to be granted access to the Owners & Trainers area when permitted, PJA badge holders must be in possession of badges and adhere to the dress code at all times.

Investec Derby Festival

PJA metal badge holders will be entitled to free admission during the Investec Derby Festival, although the PJA metal badge will not gain access to the Parade Ring or Prince's Stand unless a Jockey is engaged to ride. Jockeys riding in any race across the two days will be entitled to two complimentary Owners & Trainers guest badges (these are strictly for family and close friends). All badge requests should be made in advance by contacting Amy Bone on amy.bone@thejockeyclub.co.uk. Jockeys must adhere to the dress code on both days of the Festival.

Royal Ascot

Flat jockeys riding at the meeting will be issued with a named Owners and Trainers badge upon presentation of their PASS Card at the Owners and Trainers Desk. Jockeys riding at the meeting will be issued with TWO guest Owners and Trainers Badges. Ascot will not take Jockey badge requests over the telephone and must be made by email or via the PJA.

Admittance for other jockeys and PJA Badge holders will be considered upon prior application in writing to the PJA – **please email Vicky Lee on vl@thepja.co.uk**

British Champions Day

PJA badges are valid and strictly non-transferable. Please note that ALL jockeys riding at the meeting must have their metal badge in their possession to obtain access to the paddock and weighing room. Jockeys riding at the meeting will be issued with TWO guest Owners and Trainers Badges.

Jockeys with a PJA badge who are not riding will NOT be issued with guest badges.

Aintree – The Randox Health Grand National Meeting

Metal PJA badges are not valid for the Meeting. Jump Jockeys riding at the Meeting will be issued with one Owners and Trainers badge for themselves and TWO Owners and Trainers guest badges (these are strictly for family and close friends). These will be issued at the Owners and Trainers Reception, in the horsebox park, within the Racecourse, subject to PASS Card and satisfactory ID being shown (It is not possible to issue guest badges by telephone, fax or email.)

Admittance for other jockeys and PJA Badge holders will be considered upon prior application, in writing, to the PJA – **please email Vicky Lee on vl@thepja.co.uk**
